 - ii. Sewer Department:
 - 1. Meeting 10/11 with engineers and construction contractor to wrap up sewer project
 - 2. Reviewed the Agreement dated 10/5 between Olver Associates and the Sewer Department to do a "system wide loading review" of TSS and BOD by collecting multiple samples at the same time throughout the collection system. The object of the study is to understand why the *influent* values are so much higher than should be found in a small system like North Haven's.
