

To Jeremiah MacDonald, a resident of the Town of North Haven, in the County of Knox, in the State of Maine,

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the said Town of North Haven, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the North Haven Community Building, on Thursday, the twenty first day of July, A.D. 2022 at 7 o'clock in the afternoon, to act on the following articles to wit:

1. To choose a moderator.
2. To see if the Town will vote to create a Public Safety Building Reserve Account for the purpose of accumulating money for the construction of a new Public Safety Building. **(Select Board recommends approval.)**
3. To see if the Town will authorize the transfer of \$40,000 from the Town Garage Reserve Account to the Public Safety Building Reserve Account. **(Select Board recommends approval.) (The balance in the Town Garage Reserve Account at the time this warrant was approved was \$60,475.92, which would leave \$20,475.92 in the Town Garage Reserve Account for maintenance of that building.)**
4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$90,000 for the Public Safety Building Reserve Account. **(Budget Committee recommends approval. Select Board recommends approval.)**




