

Town of North Haven Contractor Guidance — COVID-19

Goal: Eliminate the risk of transmitting COVID-19 while allowing work to continue in businesses and activities deemed “essential” by Governor Mills’s orders of March 24, 2020 and March 31, 2020.

Contractors traveling to and from North Haven can meet the goal by:

1. Performing all work in isolation from other people — contractors must coordinate their work with that of their subcontractors;
2. Maintaining at least 6 feet between workers on the jobsite;
3. Wearing masks and gloves on the jobsite if other people are present or likely to be present;
4. Bringing all food, water, medicines, and other personal supplies to the island, and by not visiting the North Haven Grocery or other businesses on the island;
5. If remaining overnight, making arrangements to stay on the jobsite or in an isolated space, separate from other people;
6. If traveling by Maine State Ferry Service, remaining in their vehicles with the windows closed while in transit or, if traveling as a walk-on passenger, maintaining 6 feet or more between passengers;
7. If traveling by air, wearing a mask, gloves, and protective clothing (such as a Tyvek suit) while in the aircraft, bagging that personal protective gear up after exiting the aircraft, and keeping the gear in the bag for reuse on the way back to the mainland — use hand sanitizer to clean your hands before putting on the protective gear;
8. If driving (via ferry), obtaining gas before leaving the mainland or, if picking up a vehicle on North Haven, by arranging to have someone put fuel in the vehicle using a portable container;
9. Washing their hands or, in the absence of a sink and running water, sanitizing their hands after touching common surfaces, such as door handles; and
10. Following U.S. and Maine CDC COVID-19 guidance, including any updates to that guidance.

Note: This guidance is subject to change as more information becomes known about COVID-19 and as local, state, and federal authorities update orders, policies, regulations, and laws related to the virus.
